Klaus Ib Jørgensen: Moon-pain (2003-8) Facts about the work

Moon-pain is a cycle of six works, based on poems by the Portuguese poet *Fernando Pessoa* (1888-1935). Pessoa grew up in South Africa and was bilingual in Portuguese and English, and the five poems for *Moon-pain* are taken from the English collection *The Mad Fiddler* (c. 1915-17).

Instrumentation

The music is composed for an ensemble consisting of mezzo-soprano and six instruments (flute, clarinet, piano, violin, viola and cello), and all of the movements of the cycle are written for combinations of these instruments. The 6th movement is purely instrumental.
